<u>Attendance</u> is very important for your student's education. Please try to keep absences and tardiness to a minimum.

All students arriving after the second bell need to stop by the office. Students arriving late may be issued a tardy.

If your student is absent, please contact the office as soon as possible.

<u>Free breakfast</u> for all students is available at school from 8:00-8:25. Free and reduced lunch forms will be mailed to each household. These need to be filled out each year (one per family) and returned to the school kitchen or Food Service Office. Forms are also available online and in the office.

<u>Bussing</u>: The transportation office will be mailing out postcards to families that are eligible for transportation. All necessary information will be on the card. Please have your student at the bus stop 10 minutes prior to time indicated.

Highly Qualified Staff:

At the beginning of each school year, any parent who has a child attending any school receiving Title I funds may request and receive, in a timely manner, information regarding the professional qualifications of the student's classroom teachers. In addition, the parents may also ask whether the child is provided services by a paraprofessional and, if so, his or her qualifications.

At Lincoln Elementary, we are very proud of our teachers and feel they are ready for the coming school year and are prepared to give your child a high-quality education. Our staff is committed to helping your child develop the academic knowledge and critical thinking he/she needs to succeed in school and beyond. That commitment includes making sure that all of our teachers and paraprofessionals are highly skilled.
